Financial Report

After a presentation by Scty/Treas Joe Merola, Tim Drago moved to accept the 2007 Financial Report.

A. New Business

1. President Buddy Wright opens a discussion about this year's cost to put on the State Shoot. The cost of awards and prizes was about \$5000 this year and represents the largest single cost of the shoot.

Discussion:

Bill Nelson feels that the cost is appropriate, in that this is the largest shoot of the year and represents a finale for the skeet shooting year.

Tim Drago feels that it should be up to the Executive Committee to decide the budget for awards and expenses.

Mike Forshay added that awards and prizes should represent approximately 50% of the cost of the shoot.

Gary Wilson reminded the group that the Association should attempt to keep twice the annual budget in reserve as a safety precaution for unexpected costs.

Jerry Gunter asked the Executive Committee their opinion on awards vs. money; Buddy likes awards.

Tom Jones makes a motion to keep awards but limit to 40% of the shoots projected shoot income.

Patrick Carroll seconds the motion and it is voted on by the membership and passes.

2. Junior Shooters

Jackson Littleton asks the Executive Committee to reduce the cost of shooting for junior shooters at the State Shoot. The matter will be discussed by the Committee.
